Seward County Community College (SCCC), Garden City Community College (GCCC), and Dodge City Community College (DCCC) offer students the opportunity to complete an **Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Respiratory Therapy**. These partnerships enable the student to complete the general education courses at GCCC or DCCC and the core curriculum through Seward County Community College. The student may attend the program's lectures via real-time video conferencing at either GCCC or DCCC campuses and labs every other week at SCCC. The first two semesters of clinical rotations will be assigned and completed in the southwest Kansas region. The final semesters and critical care clinical rotations will be completed in Wichita, Oklahoma City, Amarillo and Lubbock, Texas.

The curriculum guides below list the courses the student enrolls in from GCCC or DCCC and the courses from Seward County Community College to complete the 1 + 1 Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Respiratory Therapy.

- English Composition II or Public Speaking.....3
- General Psychology.....3
- College Chemistry.....5
- Microbiology.....5

The student may take General Psychology, Comp II or Public Speaking, and **either** Microbiology or Chemistry while in the program.

The student must obtain a 2.5 GPA for the pre-requisite courses, not overall GPA. This will ensure the student is prepared for the rigor of the Respiratory Therapy program's curriculum.
