She is a founding member and president of Midwest HPNA, the only local Hospice and Palliative Nurses Association chapter in the state of Kansas. She serves on the Kansas Palliative Care and Quality of Life Interdisciplinary Council and is currently serving as the ACT Lead Volunteer for the 2nd Congressional District for the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network. She has been active in lobbying for legislation to improve the accessibility and quality of palliative care services to anyone with serious, life limiting illness as well as legislation that improves care for those facing a cancer diagnosis.
